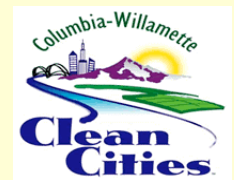
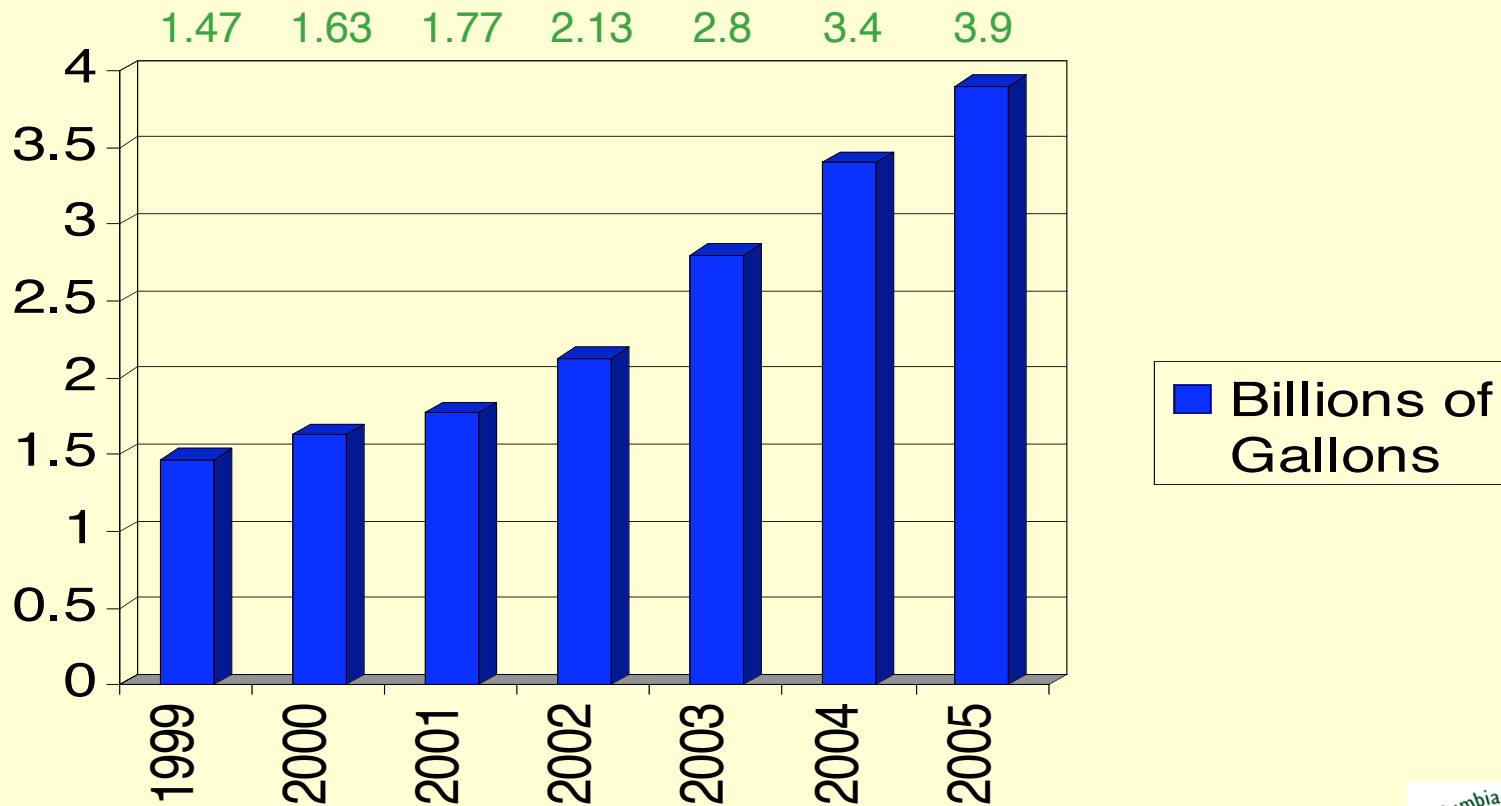


Gasoline Highway Use

- **140 Billion Gal/yr of gasoline used on US highways.**
- **1.53 Billion Gal/yr of gasoline used on Oregon highways (1.1% of US total)**
- **2.65 Billion Gal/yr of gasoline used on Washington highways (1.9% of US total)**
 - **4.18 Billion Gal/yr NW total for 3% of US use**

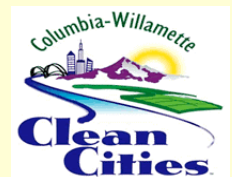
US Ethanol Production





US Ethanol Capacity

- **As of 11/17/2006 US annual ethanol production capacity is at 5.12 Billion gal/yr. 3.7 % of US gasoline use.**
- **Estimated capacity by mid 2008 is 8.9 Billion gal/yr. 6.4 % of US gasoline use.**
- **2005 Energy Bill Law**
 - **2006 RFS of 4 Billion Gal/yr.**
 - **2012 RFS of 7.5 Billion Gal/yr.**





Northwest Ethanol Capacity

- **No current commercial production**
- **By mid 2008 estimated ethanol production in the Northwest will be 223 million Gal/yr.**
- **Ethanol production would come to 5.3 % of gasoline consumption for the Northwest.**
